



The Ginger Butchers Outlet Denby Pottery Village

It is with regret that we have taken the decision to withdraw our Ginger Butchers outlet from Denby Pottery Village.

We opened the Farm Shop and Butchers Counter at Denby in August 2020 at a time when no-one realised the pandemic was going to continue into 2021. We maintained a retail presence at Denby for as long as we could, with twice weekly Click & Collect deliveries during lockdown, and relaunched our on-site Café when retail & hospitality were allowed to fully reopen. However, both sectors have been hit extremely hard by Covid and we have therefore decided to focus our efforts on our core business at Bakewell and our growing event catering business – the Ginger Cooks.

The Ginger Butchers outlet at Denby will remain open until the end of October 2021, but from today, Friday 8 October 2021, our Farm Shop in Denby will only supply our high quality, farm-reared, pre-packed meat products within its refrigerated units. The Ginger Cooks Café will remain open for hot drinks and light refreshments until 2pm on Friday 29 October.

Online and telephone ordering with Click & Collect from Denby will operate as normal during October 2021, with the collection point now at our Deli Counter.

Online ordering for home delivery remains unaffected with Click & Collect available from Bakewell or our farm in Over Haddon only from November onwards.

We're pleased to share that Denby will be continuing with a new Butchers and Farm Shop when we depart, stocking locally sourced produce and continuing to sell Laithwaites wines. In addition, there will be a new Tea House offering light refreshments and afternoon teas.

We would like to thank all our Denby customers for their loyalty and support during the last 12 months and the Denby team for making us so welcome, without you all we would have really struggled through the ups and downs of the pandemic.
